VeriSign, Inc. is the leading provider of digital trust services that enable everyone, everywhere to engage in commerce and communications with confidence. Digital trust services create a trusted environment through four core offerings—Web presence services, security services, payment services, and telecommunications services—powered by a global infrastructure that manages more than seven billion communications and transactions a day.

### VeriSign® Global Registry Services

- Manages the definitive database of over 27.5 million names in the .com, .net, and .org generic top-level domains (gTLDs)
- Owns and maintains the DNS constellation of 13 gTLD name servers around the globe that respond to more than 7 billion look-ups per day
- Provides equal, 24x7 access to the gTLD registries for over 100 ICANN-accredited registrars through its Shared Registration System (SRS)

### Telecommunications Services

- 1,004 SS7 Signaling Points
- 7.9 billion database queries quarterly

### Authentication Services

- Over 95,000 Web site certificates issued in Q3 2002 for a total of 400,000 certificates
- VeriSign ended Q3 2002 with 46 affiliates
